**Directions To Linwood Middle School**  
**25 Linwood Place**  
**North Brunswick, NJ 08902**

*Parking is across from the school and on the left side of the school. **Entrance to Festival is at the front of the school - double blue doors on left.***

**Route 1 South** – Pass Route 18. Construction is in front of Cook College. You can bear right or left when Route 1 divides. Take Milltown Road North (immediately after construction). Left at first light (Rt. 171-facing Little Caesars Pizza). Right at 1<sup>st</sup> light (Hermann Road). Right at 1<sup>st</sup> light (Linwood Avenue). School is on right.

**Route 1 North** – Take Livingston Avenue exit (26 North) toward New Brunswick. Make right at fourth traffic light – Hermann Avenue (***Sign is hard to read -Exxon Station is on the corner at the light***). Make left at first light (Linwood Avenue). School is on right.

**Route 18** – Exit at Route 1 South. Follow directions from 1 South above.
